Parents,

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of what you and your daughter can expect in Cambridge should she be selected, and accept the offer to play on the 2019-20 Midget B Team next season.

The coaching staff will include Aaron GOODING (Head Coach), Fraser GALER (Assistant Coach) and non-parent Adam MORRIS (Assistant Coach). We have coached together for several years and most recently Coach Adam and I coached together on the Bantam 1 team, while Coach Fraser was an assistant on Bantam BB.

Character building and skill development are our primary objectives, and our team mantra is Play Hard, Have Fun!

Winning hockey games is NOT our top priority, we have set out goals for our team, and we will work with the parents and players to set and achieve individual goals.

This team will play smart, high tempo hockey. Our goals and expectations will be to:

- Make smart hockey decisions they may not always work but good decision making will be a focus
 - Be among the teams with the fewest penalty minutes
- Empower the players (as a group) to select one drill per practice. (this will engage the girls and allow them to tailor the drills for their personal development)
