

ARENA PARTICIPANT EXPECTATIONS

All participants must come dressed in their equipment minus skates and helmets. A dedicated washroom will be available if needed. Please follow postings at the arena.

Only one Parent/Guardian spectator per participant is permitted in the arena. **No exceptions.**

All participants AND spectators must complete a Health screening questionnaire before each ice time

All players, bench staff AND spectators must be included on a COVID tracking sheet at each ice time

Arena doors are always locked. Entrance for ice time is 10 minutes before the scheduled ice time

Spectators must enter the arena with the team, immediately after the players and bench staff have entered.

Entrance and exit doors are identified at each arena with signage that must be followed.

If someone leaves the arena , they will not be permitted back in.

All spectators are required to sit in designated areas and follow social distancing rules.

Participants must be masked upon entering the building and the mask can only come off when the helmet is put on just before going on the ice.

All spectators must always wear a mask while in the building.

Dressing rooms are not open at this time, designated chairs are used for putting skates and helmets on.

The Parent/Guardian is permitted to assist with tying skates and then must go to the designated seating arena. No gathering in the arena lobby.

Please remember the arena staff is there to ensure that CrGHA teams are following the rules. Any abuse of staff or volunteers may result in the offender not being permitted access to the arena.
